  - Sustainable made out of abundant raw materials (such as linseed oil, waxes and natural resins) not crude oil
- Don't work... as with all products need correct application.
- high maintenance... easy to rejuvenate and repair surface with minimal effort.





## Optimal storage of product

Decant any unused oil into a smaller container for future use. As these are natural oils they cure with air/ventilation and light, if a tin is half empty it will start the curing process thus making the oil go "off" and become unusable.







#### Rejuvenation of surfaces

If or when the surface looks matte, dry or is not repelling water as it should (depending on the project the oil has been used on) apply a thin layer of the original oil used then wipe off or polish in excess after 10 minutes. It is recommended (if e.g. Tables, benches etc) not to use the surface for 12 hours.















